

ORDINANCE NO. 169

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A PORTION OF SOUTH TENTH STREET, BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH TENTH AND WALNUT STREETS AND EXTENDING IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE MIDDLE OF SOUTH TENTH STREET TO APPROXIMATELY 200 FEET BEYOND THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH TENTH AND OAK STREETS.

The Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, in special meeting assembled, being duly authorized so to do and having in all ways complied with the provisions of Section 1101 et seq. (53 P.S. 66101) of the Second Class Township Code, as amended, do hereby enact and ordain that a portion of South Tenth Street be opened as a public street, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the north curb line (projected) of Walnut Street, said point marking the intersection of the north curb line (projected) of said Walnut Street and the westerly right-of-way line (projected) of South Tenth Street; thence along the north curb line (projected) of Walnut Street North 75 Degrees 37 Minutes 09 Seconds East 30.41 feet to a point; thence through South Tenth Street and along a portion of South Tenth Street about to be ordained by Bangor Borough North 16 Degrees 52 Minutes 17 Seconds East 774.29 feet to a point; thence along same North 15 Degrees 23 Minutes 25 Seconds East 206.29 feet to a spike; thence through said South Tenth Street North 47 Degrees 40 Minutes 01 Seconds West 29.17 feet to a point; thence along land of Bangor Borough South 15 Degrees 23 Minutes 25 Seconds West 219.17 feet to a point; thence partly along same and partly along land of Juliana Skrapits South 16 Degrees 52 Minutes 17 Seconds West 789.73 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 25,867 square feet.

The location and width of the aforesaid proposed public street and the names of the owners of the property whereon said road abuts, as required by the Second Class Township Code, as

amended, is set forth upon a map or plan made by the Township Engineer, Robert L. Collura, Registered Engineer, dated July 10, 1987.

Enacted and ordained as an Ordinance of Washington Township this 29th day of June, 1988.
