ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING PREVIOUS POLICE PENSION ORDINANCE NO. 152, ENACTED DECEMBER 30, 1968, AS WELL AS THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS THERETO: NOVEMBER 14, 1977, MAY 14, 1979, APRIL 13, 1983, APRIL 11, 1990, AUGUST 10, 1994, AND OCTOBER 12, 1994, AND ENACTING AND ESTABLISHING A NEW POLICE PENSION PLAN FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: REPEALER

This Ordinance specifically replaces all other ordinances or parts of ordinances establishing provisions for the Police Pension Plan. This Ordinance further replaces the retirement plan for the police officers of Washington Township through the adoption of the Washington Township Police Retirement Plan.

SECTION 2: ESTABLISHMENT

This Ordinance establishes a retirement plan for the Police Officers of Washington Township through the adoption of the Pension Document, effective June 11, 1997.

SECTION 3: SAVINGS PROVISIONS

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Retirement Plan shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of the Retirement Plan, it being the intent of the Township that such remainder shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4:

This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment hereof.
