ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING A LAWFUL SPEED LIMIT ON HEINSOHN HILL ROAD, FOR ITS ENTIRE LENGTH WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, AT THIRTY-FIVE (35) MILES PER HOUR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined, through the Township Engineer, that it is in the best interests of the Township to establish the following speed limit on Heinsohn Hill Road, within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the said Township Engineer has conducted a study to clearly define an appropriate speed limit for said roadway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that Heinsohn Hill Road, for its entire length within the Township, shall be properly marked with speed limit signs of thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

All other Ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
