ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING A LAWFUL SPEED LIMIT ON GREENTREE DRIVE, FOR ITS ENTIRE LENGTH WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, AT TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1: The Township of Washington, a Second Class Township of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, has determined that Greentree Drive is a local street.

Section 2: The Board of Supervisors and the Township Engineer have determined that the speed limit for Greentree Drive shall be established at twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Section 3: The speed limit for Greentree Drive is hereby established at twenty-five (25) miles per hour from the Township boundary with the Borough of Bangor to the terminus of Greentree Drive at Stiles Road.

Section 4: All other Ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment.
