ORDINANCE NO. 260

AN ORDINANCE OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, NORTHAMPTON
COUNTY
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS AT BRODT
ROAD AT JOHNSON ROAD AND FLICKSVILLE ROAD AT SHORT ROAD
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have received reports from the Township Engineer dated August 20, 2007, and November 2, 2007, indicating a need for installation of stop signs at two (2) separate locations within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors find it necessary to install stop signs at the aforementioned locations based upon review of the said engineer's reports.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors, at a duly convened public meeting thereof as follows:

Section 1: A stop sign shall be installed on the west bound Flicksville Road approach to Flicksville Road's intersection with Short Road.

Section 2: A stop sign installation shall be authorized on the south bound Brodt Road approach to Brodt's Road intersection with Johnson Road.

Section 3: Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 4: Construction of the aforementioned stop signs shall be in compliance with the report of the Township's consulting Engineers, Keystone Consulting Engineers, Inc., dated November 2, 2007, and August 20, 2007. All

Recommendations contained in said report shall be followed in conjunction with installation of the aforementioned stop signs.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment hereof.

THIS ORDINANCE ORDAINED AND ENACTED being duly presented by motion and duly seconded was carried and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township at a public meeting held on the 14th day of November, 2007.
