**ORDINANCE NO. 262**

AN ORDINANCE OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP,  
NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
ESTABLISHING A STOP SIGN ON JOHNSON ROAD AT THE  
INTERSECTION OF JOHNSON ROAD, TRUE BLUE ROAD,  
NAGY'S HILL ROAD AND RASLEY ROAD, ALL  
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have received a report from the Township Engineer dated March 27, 2008, indicating a need for installation of a stop sign at one (1) location within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors find it necessary to install a stop sign at the aforementioned location based upon review of the said engineer's report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors, at a duly convened public meeting thereof as follows:

Section 1: A stop sign shall be installed on Johnson Road at the intersection of Johnson Road, True Blue Road, Nagy's Hill Road and Rasley Road.

Section 2. Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.


Section 3. Construction of the aforementioned stop sign shall be in compliance with the report of the Township's consulting engineers, Ott Consulting Inc., dated March 27, 2008. All recommendations contained in said


report shall be followed in conjunction with installation of the aforementioned stop sign.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment hereof.
