ORDINANCE NO. 281

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON PORTIONS OF RUTT ROAD WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, through its duly appointed engineer, Ott Consulting Inc., has conducted a traffic study of Rutt Road to determine a speed limit for said road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to use the results of the aforementioned study to establish speed limits on portions of said Rutt Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1:

The speed limit for Rutt Road between the Township line near Kline Street to a point 800 feet east of the centerline of Chris Court be established and posted at 30 Miles Per Hour.

Section 2:

The speed limit for Rutt Road in the zone between beginning at a point 800 feet east of the centerline of Christ Court to the intersection with Locke Heights Road shall be established and posted at 25 Miles Per Hour.

Section 3:

Any ordinance, or part thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 4:

This Ordinance shall be placed into effect immediately upon enactment.

Section 5:

Any violations of this Ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code for regulations of speed on public roadways.
