ORDINANCE NO. 302

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ABOLISHING ORDINANCES NO. 177, NO. 194, NO. 252 AND NO. 269, EFFECTIVE IMMEDITALY UPON ENACTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 177, Ordinance No. 194, Ordinance No. 252 and Ordinance No. 269 are hereby repealed and abolished in their entirety, since the Township is no longer authorized to issue licenses for contractors, subcontractors, excavators, electricians, plumbers, lawn service, tree trimmers and pavers.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance will be placed into effect immediately upon enactment.
