## MEETING MINUTES

February 24, 2026

Call to Order: Steve Sanders called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Committee Board Reorganization:

Old Business:

- Little Free Library: We received a quote from Little Free Library in the amount of \$419.38 for their composite two-story kit. Lisa is clarifying the payment options, as we may need to pay by two methods.
- Dog Park: We received quotes from three different companies for dog park agility courses. The committee recommends Dog-on-It Parks' Canine Courtyard Essentials kit. Lisa is clarifying the cost before an order is placed.

New Business:

- Spring clean-up: The committee discussed having a clean-up day, either for individuals, the committee, the community, or for a school group. The committee decided to table the discussion till after the snow melts. At that future date, the committee will make an assessment of the park's needs
- Snowmobile use in the park: Nelson pointed out that snowmobile tracks have been observed crossing the park grounds between Rt. 191 and Ackermanville Road. Because such usage is not permitted and could be a liability for the township, the committee recommends that the Board of Supervisors add this item to their next agenda.

- March 24 meeting: Steve will be away when the committee meets on March 24. Barring any unforeseen commitments, Nelson will run the meeting.
