1. Call to Order: Justin Huratiak called the meeting to order at 7:15pm

2. Approval of Agenda

7. Board of Supervisors Report: Supervisor Huratiak reported that the on-going trailer park issue is making progress. Also, the dumpster & increased police patrol on the township property were addressed.

 - a. Justin confirmed that no one attended the Livable Landscape Grant (which makes us ineligible to apply for the grant this year.) Next year this will be addressed to have representation at the meeting.
 - b. Discussion regarding drywall in the dumpster was addressed and the police department will keep an eye on it. A locking dumpster is not desirable.
 - c. Terry reexamined the placement of the horseshoe court, possible removable pins, and using special mud for the pits to reduce the horseshoes from leaving

the pit when thrown. Al will check on the availability of the mud. Next month's meeting will begin at the pavilion at 7:00 pm

- d. Justine will ask Katie to order an additional trash can to be placed on the lower walking trail near the bench.

10. New Business:

- e. Terry identified the multiple trees that have been planted along the walking trails as European/Scandinavian Beech Trees.
- f. Terry will investigate the possibility of a Wildflower Program & Planting in addition to planting Sycamores and Willows by the wetland pond area.
